

STEP DETAILS

- 1. **APPLY ONLINE:** Apply at www.eauclairewi.gov/jobs.
- 2. WRITTEN/PHYSICAL TESTING: The written examination is comprised of a multiple choice exam that includes cognitive and attitude/personality components, followed by a short written exercise. The written test will be completed in under 3 hours. On the same day, all candidates will participate in the physical agility testing. Since both tests are held on the same day, you may come dressed in your athletic apparel and/or casual clothing. See below for details.
- 3. POLICE & FIRE COMMISSION (PFC) ORAL INTERVIEW: Candidates who are chosen by the PFC will be placed on an Eligibility List. You will be notified of your placement via email about 24 hours after interviews.
- 4. CHIEF STAFF INTERVIEW: Police Department staff schedule interviews.
- 5. BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION & ADDITIONAL TESTING: Candidates selected to move forward will undergo a detailed background investigation and will be required to participate and successfully pass a polygraph examination, psychological evaluation, chemical substance screening test, and a physical/medical evaluation.

PHYSICAL AGILITY TESTING INFORMATION

You must pass each exercise by the minimal cutoff score:

- AEROBIC CAPACITY: 1.5 mile run
 - Maximum Time = 16:57 min/sec.
- ANAEROBIC POWER: 300 meter sprint
 - Maximum Time = 68 sec.
- MUSCULAR ENDURANCE: Sit-ups
 - Minimum repetitions = 30 in one minute
- ANAEROBIC POWER: Vertical jump
 - Minimum Height = 14 inches
- ANAEROBIC CAPACITY: Agility run
 - Maximum Time = 19.5 sec. (See course to right)
- MUSCULAR ENDURANCE: Push-ups
 - Minimum Repetitions = 23
